THE COMMUNITY

The Empower The People Association launched on 21 March 2022, with the stated objectives of bringing men and women together from around the earth plain we live upon, to effect change for the betterment of mankind.

We are in times of great uncertainty. Many have awakened from their slumber to realise the life they were living, and their purpose, are no longer what they thought it was, having been tricked by a grand illusion that has kept the conscience of humanity wilfully and ignorantly imprisoned for decades.

In the same period, we have completed almost 2,000 orders resulting in c. 8,000 member benefits being accessed and fulfilled, and we have been able to assist many of our members with subsidies and discounts to the value of £40,000, demonstrating that as a community, we remain true to our word, helping those most vulnerable and acting equitably towards our members.

And now we build.

To drive our community endeavours further, we have an active forum and marketplace within the platform where members can connect, exchange, support, and encourage one another, ask questions, and share their experiences.

We have created a 'Buddy Up' mapping system so that our members can find and connect to other local Empower The People members, and we also have a family chat messaging channel for instant messaging between members and the team.

The story ahead of us is yet to unfold, but with a determined heart, tenacious attitude, focused mind, and a humble spirit, there is no doubt that this living breathing community we call the 'Empower the People Association' is destined to achieve great works, and the Empower The People Trustees and Team are unimaginably delighted to be manifesting these things into reality with you.

Our association is now over 1200 strong with a consistent increase of between 40 – 60 new members each month representing a healthy and steady growth of 3 – 7% month on month.

Whilst we experienced a loss of around 14% of the membership in August 2022 following the "Fall-Out", EtP has bounced back and is stronger than ever.

Throughout 2022, we experienced a consistent 20% of the membership actively contributing by way of a paid membership plan whilst 80% continued as a free member. It was quite something to see the 80/20 rule play out in real-time.

Following the SGM and members vote in January 2023, it was agreed to implement new membership plans in an attempt to stimulate 100% of the membership contributing towards our end goals since we are a family on a mission.

It has only been a month into the new plans, and we are already seeing a greater number of members now contributing and committing to our success with a 27% increase from 225 members in February to 307 by the end of March.

In addition to membership plan changes, the members voted in constitutional changes to reflect what our members expect from fellow members of this growing community and to enhance the security of our platform following the theft of our IP and confidential data last July. The changes include a rule that our members must attend at least one weekly member's meeting within every 6-month period (i.e. minimum of two meetings per year, excluding General Meetings).

Part of the reason behind this is because we want active and engaged members - it isn't much of a community if it is not a living and breathing body - but we really need to wait for the new plans to wash through before considering purging any inactive accounts (over six months).

We anticipate our membership numbers to contract over the next three to six months as this will become a regular membership maintenance programme to ensure our community is ALIVE, ALERT, and ACTIVE.



Our membership support team are looking forward to this next year ahead and the many new faces to welcome through our proverbial doors.


Total Members

Total Paid


BENEFITS AND PRIVILEGES

As an association that sets out to guide and support our members in the best way we can, we have undertaken almost **600** Technical Support sessions assisting members through a variety of circumstances from defending property repossessions, debt disputes, and other court related matters, to dealing with utility billing agents, debt collections agents, and police.

We have prepared and delivered over **120** trust documents thereby protecting our members' property and assets in creative ways that de-risk them from future piracy.

In addition, we have processed over **80** Payment Reclaims (1099 OID) on behalf of our members, and if successful this will provide those members with much needed spending power, which in turn can be used for the greater good because it sits in the hands of those who are awake and aligned with the ethos of equity. This gamechanger may just become a catalyst for the future success of this association and its objectives.

DEBT MANAGEMENT

When I started with Empower The People in August 2022 I took over 47 accounts for 15 members. In the seven months this has grown by **c. 61%** (an increase of **8.5%** per month). We now service **73** accounts for **28** members and a combined debt of **c. £614,000**.

Our vehicle for Debt Wipe was originally conceived and created in 2010. The strategy was rolled out to members in August 2022, and most lenders have now corresponded with us. Members are reminded to keep me informed of any communications they receive.

I am currently applying credit repair techniques for members once their lender has fallen silent, and whilst success cannot be guaranteed in 100% of cases the methodology employed has been successful over the past 12 years. Its to early in the process with ETP member accounts, to have had any significant successes with debts being officially written off or companies having fallen silent, however several debts were immediately sold upon the receipt of the first letter, and if the number of accounts we manage continues to grow at the same rate, there will be sufficient cases for a fulltime role for me, eliminating unsecured debts for EtP members.

Debt Outlook

We anticipate that debt defaults will increase substantially in the coming years with StepChange are already reporting a 24% (18,000 people) increase in those seeking debt advice in January 2023 alone ¹

With new debt records being hit every month, the increase appears global and is not just limited to the our domestic market², although the UK is apparently in the worst shape in Europe³

Most of the increase is fallout from the covid-19 pandemic/lockdown which saw many businesses forced to close and many individuals unable to work. The governments help schemes that were put into place were only covering a percentage of the loss of income that people and businesses had, and around a million people who were not employed or self-employed, but in some other capacity at the time (including myself) got no help whatsoever and had zero income during the covid-19 lockdowns.

Inflation, cost of living, food prices, utility bills and interest rates will continue to rise as more and more credit is created, diluting the overall currency supply, meaning more currency is chasing less real goods, services and assets, the end result has to be inflation and an increase in their prices.

Empower The People has prepared itself for a surge in people and businesses seeking alternative help,

MORTGAGE CHALLENGE

We are celebrating one year of Empower The People. One year of empowering YOU.

Empower the People was created out of an idea and perhaps a need to bring a community together, to share knowledge in a space where we operate in harmony and equity.

The path has not always been an easy one. We had some challenges along the way; we adapted and through vision, drive and perseverance we overcame those challenges.

I am a firm believer that everything happens for a reason and that those challenges and experiences we go through shape, not only us as individuals, but also as a collective; they make us stronger in the face of adversity.

With that in mind it is wonderful to see how far we truly have come.

We currently have **40** members and **63** mortgage accounts progressing with the Mortgage Challenge process.

A few have only just commenced Phase 1; Discovery where we request and collate documents from Lenders, Conveyancers and Land Registry in order to prepare a tailored Discovery Report, providing a summary of key findings and recommendations in relation to a mortgage.

Of those 40 members, 16 have commenced Phase 2; the Lender private process, in which we agree the facts with a member's Lender via affidavit and this agreement will be acquired through "tacit procuration" (agreement by silence).

In order to achieve the best possible outcome for our members, we have created a Mortgage Challenge Roundtable, which consists of highly knowledgeable members of the ETP team. The Roundtable holds frequent meetings to brainstorm and discuss arguments and lines of attacks that can be utilised in the Mortgage Challenge process.

The future looks bright. It fills me with joy and happiness to see the continued growth of Empower The People, to see how far we have come and to be part of such a wonderful team and community.

Here's to empowerment!

HEALTH AND WELLBEING

Since joining ETP, I have thoroughly enjoyed being a part of the Executive Committee and helping to develop and deliver a private healthcare service with the assistance of Deedee Phoenix, another qualified practitioner and therapist amongst our ranks.

We are in an interesting and uncertain phase in our lives with the National Health Service (NHS) in freefall and appearing unable to support the demands required in the modern era.

Thanks to the integral support of ETP, a truly incredible association, we are now able to assist our members a broad-spectrum support on health issues including physical and mental wellbeing therapies.

Financial Performance

In spite of all the challenges associated with any new endeavour, and the added challenges associated with the "Fall-Out", the PMA received donations in excess of £296,000.00.

This figure conceals five months of uncertainty (from August to December inclusive) during which donations to the Association were negatively impacted by the Fall-Out.

Interestingly, staff costs for the four months to end July (representing the old team) were around £95,570. Based on these figures, had we kept the old team we would have incurred an annual staff cost in the region of £286,710.

Compare this to the new team, possessing vastly greater experience and integrity, who have cost £117,656 for the eight months from August to March. Working on these figures, the new run rate is at £176,484 for the year, demonstrating a dramatic saving over the old team, and I believe this also shows (in financial form), the difference in attitude toward money and compensation between the old and the new.

Of course, these much needed savings are destined for charitable works and improving our solutions and offering for our members.

The accounts, now in their final form, show the true cost of delivering benefits and privileges to the membership and explains why members are required to donate for services. Administrative costs for the year were £127,650, a cost most PEOPLE rarely make allowance for when demanding THAT assistance be provided for free.

Financial Risk

Deducting staff costs and administrative costs from donations leaves us with a surplus of £15,228.60.

This is super news to report in our first year, however, this annual surplus is "artificial" because it contains an outstanding invoice to MF Solutions Ltd for a sum in the region of: £22,000, which is yet to be collected.

The amount that is owed to ETP comprises as follows:

- c. £17,000 in over charged VAT, and
- c. £3,000 equipment retained by MF Solutions but paid for by ETP, and
- c. £2,000 rental deposit

This is in addition to our estimates of around £300,000 in donations that ETP has been deprived of as a result of the Fall Out, and it is our hope that our members can now see, in financial terms, the very real effects and harm caused by a breach of trust and abuse of position.

Financial Results

Our first year has ended with a strong final quarter which bodes well for the forthcoming year, but as is patently obvious we will be unable to make any good-cause community grants this year. I have no doubt whatsoever that had we not experienced the interruption in July, our figures would present even more positively, and as disappointing as this may be, we must remain bullish about the year ahead.

Our membership requirements have been altered so as to require financial support in the form of contributions from all members. With an enhanced focus on equitable (two-way) support, and with ground-breaking technologies planned for roll-out over the coming year, we anticipate attracting the right type of people to join our association.

History has taught us that numbers of people is not the answer: what we need are the right people; those who possess a balanced/equitable outlook.

With that in mind, all members should be proud of what they have helped to support and achieve this past year - without you, this Association would be meaningless.

Despite the adverse result in terms of being able to fund community initiatives, we must recognise that this does not truly reflect what we have achieved and experienced together which is far more valuable and a far greater blessing.

These accounts for the year ended 31 March 2023, have been reconciled, audited, and signed off by our independent accountants.

CROWDFUNDING

Despite Empower The People being in its infancy, we have overcome some monumental challenges, not least what we refer to as the "Fall-Out" in which the ETP website was cloned and stolen by two ex-Trustees of the community for commercial gain.

The events of July 2022 served to highlight the need for policing of, and within, the truth movement.

While some may have balked at the mere contemplation of bringing private criminal proceedings against the individuals concerned, we chose to embrace the responsibility, put our heads down, and move conscientiously into battle because we felt it was, and is, the right thing to do.

Association with the truth movement does not in itself bring any guarantee of integrity. In fact, the growing movement appears to have been targeted by those who clearly lack integrity and seek only to make a fast buck from those seeking remedy outside of a corrupt CORPORATE SYSTEM and who are vulnerable due to a lack of discernment.

Following an overwhelming vote of support from members, the decision to crowdfund legal action against the ex-Trustees was launched in January 2023.

Within three short months the crowdfund has raised approximately £80,000.00 between the EtP and You and Your Cash (YaYC) memberships and we thank each and every one of you who have contributed towards this endeavour.

But it doesn't stop there ...

We have seen the need to extend crowdfunded private prosecutions to other unscrupulous persons.

Accordingly, both the ETP and YaYC platforms have made changes to pricing to deliver regular funding to this ongoing altruistic cause, which seeks not only to provide remedy for those who have been harmed, but to prevent further harm from being caused.

If you haven't yet contributed to these efforts, there are no minimum or maximum requirements, and members and non-members alike can head over to the news section of the platform to find out how to donate.


BIGGER Picture

We are also working on a technology to potentially off-set all taxes and exploring a possible way to release pensions early.

Even more exciting is our road-testing of the de-registration of birth in order to collapse the Legal Person (aka Strawman), and we are ready to deploy funds into community initiatives in line with our stated mission of charitable works, though we do need our members to drive initiatives to us for consideration.

Over the next period we will be enhancing and expanding our services to the wider public at large by taking out the trash and clearing the 'freedom movement' of those who seek to capitalise on the vulnerability of others.

Beyond this, we are preparing to facilitate our first ever ETP Freedom Festival and Conference in the summer of 2024.

There is no doubt there will be new challenges that we must face along the way but when we operate from a place of truth, equity, and justice, our light can never be extinguished.
