**RE: Letter Requesting a Scheduling Order and Written Status Update**

Dear Judge Buchwald:

I appear *pro se* in the above-captioned interpleader matter.

I write respectfully to request that the Court issue a Scheduling Order or direct the parties to submit a written status report to establish a procedural timeline for this case.

The Plaintiff's Complaint was filed in October 2025, and Defendant Amy Jo Sanger filed her Answer on January 20, 2026. The core assets in dispute—approximately \$900,000—remain frozen by the stakeholder.

To move this matter forward efficiently, I respectfully request that the Court direct the parties to submit a written proposal outlining their positions on the following immediate next steps:

1. The formal deposit of the stakeholder's funds into the Court Registry Investment System (CRIS) to ensure their absolute preservation.
2. A timeline for targeted, limited discovery—specifically GoldSilver's production of the onboarding and KYC files relied upon at the time the account was opened.
3. A timeline for referral to the SDNY Mediation Program, as requested in my November 2025 Letter Motion.

I am prepared to submit my written proposals on these matters at the Court's earliest convenience. Thank you for your time and continued management of this case.
