REVIEW OF FINANCIAL ACTIVITIES

Income

Our chief form of income was rent from the MP's office (£10,662.08) and our share of membership subs (£6,361.78). We held an online guiz which raised £1,019.78.

Expenditure

The CLP spent £5,050.29 on premises bills and maintenance. We spent £600.62 to host large online meetings via Zoom. In addition, the CLP made a contribution to the organiser salary of £5,189.39, which was offset by a donation from the Cooperative party of £1,215 and a donation from Stella Creasy's office of £2,244.59 (paid in 2022 so not included in these accounts), making the total contribution £1,729.80.
