Deadlines

We ask you to send to CCHQ Compliance by 31 March, which enables us to check for basic errors and appropriate text comments. We will continue to accept accounts at all times, but after 31 March you must send directly to the Commission if over £25,000.

Sending last minute?

If your accounts show either income or expenditure over £25,000 but under £250,000, the legal deadline for them to be received by the Electoral Commission is 30 April*.
