resigned. The Association had another successful campaign and
won their 3rd By-election.

Planning began for the NNDC Local elections coming up in May 2023 with selections commencing early in 2022.

#### Financial Activities

### Income overview

The accounts show that this year the association has managed to do some fundraising despite the Covid-19 restrictions. The association has continued to benefit by the increase in its Nelson Club members, therefore increasing the level of donations. It has also received rental income from the MP's office as it sublets some of its unused office space.

### Expenditure overview

There have been significant campaigning costs this year due to the County Council elections and the two by-elections which have happened in the year. We have had regular secretarial support which has assisted the running of the office significantly and work done on the marked registers etc. Continuing expenditure
