### **Political activities**

### Overview of political activities

2021 was an eventful year for the Association in terms of political activities. We had the County elections in May 2021, where we returned 5 out of the 7 divisional seats, losing Ashford to an Independent. Long serving Councillors Tim Evans and Richard Walsh stepped down, with Buddhi Weerasinghe and Maureen Attewell retaining these seats. Across the County the Conservatives maintained their majority with 47 out of 81 seats, down 14 from the 2017 County elections. The Liberal Democrats increased their seats by 5 (14) and the Resident Associations by 4 (12).

We also had a by election in Staines South due to the resignation of a Liberal Democrat Councillor. We won back this seat with a marginal majority of 7 votes, with a turnout of 34.5%.

Despite the very challenging circumstances at the time of the May 2021 elections the Association is very grateful to all of those who worked on the County and Borough by election campaigns.

In the Summer the Shepperton branch launched a fundraiser. This was a very well attended and successful event, and the Branch is very grateful to the Association Chairman for holding the event at his home.

We bid a fond farewell to our office support, \_\_\_\_\_. The Association officer team would like to take this opportunity to thank \_\_\_\_\_ for her ongoing support over the past years and wish her every success with her future plans and ambitions.

Spelthorne Cpf closed their account and transferred the balance to the Association with an agreement it will be used for the improvement of facilities in the office rather

than general expenditure.

In September 2021 the Surrey Area Council AGM took place and our Association Chairman was elected as Deputy Chairman (Political).

Membership was at 249 at year end.

#### **Financial Activities**

#### Income overview

While there has been a decrease in Membership Subscription income, fundraising income and donations increased compared to the previous year. Having said this the Association both centrally and at Branch level raised limited funds during 2021. Now the Government has launched the 'Living with COVID' plan we need to refocus our energies on fundraising for 2022.

### Expenditure overview

Office expenditure increased during 2021, in part due to works needed, for example, a new water heater, the installation of a smart TV to enable remote working for officers and our MP. The main contributory factor was the County elections. Consideration needs to be given to planning for the future as this is a significant cost to the Association.

### Continuing expenditure

#### Additional investment

During 2021 we increased our deposit with CCHQ, investing a further £3, 483. The deposit will accrue 1.5% interest over 5 years. For 2021 the deposit accrued interest of £128.57.

#### Balance sheet overview

The balance sheet is £257,440 this year. Fundraising has been limited, the County Elections and a By Election (Staines) in May 2021.
