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Political Activities

This year has been one of intense political activity starting with a By-election in Alcombe which we narrowly lost and moving swiftly on to the elections for the Somerset Unitary Council. Although the overall result was poor for the party, Bridgwater and West Somerset did relatively well and returned fifteen of the thirty six Councillors on

The shenanigans in Westminster have caused two leadership elections and resulted in a small drop in membership. However, two more Associations have joined the Somerset Grouping making a total of seven with the potential of nine after a General Election because of the Boundary Review.

The Association is working towards implementing the results of the Boundary Review which will split us into two, Tiverton and Minehead and Bridgwater. A Selection Council has been held for Tiverton and Minehead and the sitting MP for Bridgwater and West Somerset approved as the candidate for the next General Election, we must now wait until April 1st to begin the selection process for Bridgwater.

Financial Activities

Income Overview

Fund raising is slowly recovering with a few branches and the two luncheon clubs making good contributions to funds. We thank them for their hard work and dedication to the party. We look forward to all branches contributing now that we have an election free year.

Expenditure Overview

The Unitary Election was very expensive for the Association and attempts to recoup some of the cost from elected candidates have, so far been mostly unsuccessful. We remain hopeful that this situation will change
