We are also supporting an upcoming by-election in Chester-le -Street, and preparing for next year's Police and Crime Commissioner election.

Income and Expenditure

Income

Subscriptions from members remained the same as last year. New tenants moved into the building during the year, and our rental income was therefore considerably more than in the previous year. A summer social event added a little to our funds.

Building expenses were high again this year. Repairs to a glass roof and two new gas boilers were necessary. Professional fees incurred in finding new tenants and the legal fees involved were expensive.
