OVERVIEW OF POLITICAL ACTIVITIES

Political activities throughout the year consisted of supporting Alun Cairns MP, Andrew R T Davies MS and Joel James MS and local government councillors and council candidates in their 2022 campaign for election, along with local door to door leafleting etc. when allowed due to periodic Covid lockdowns and limited permissible activities. AGM, Executive Council and other meetings were held, and Association members and activists were kept in touch via social media.

The Vale's excellent local government candidates ran a strong campaign but unfortunately, partially owing to the national political climate at the time of the election, only ten Conservatives were elected from the Vale.

MEMBERSHIP

At year end the membership of the unit was 386 (396 at the end of 2021).

BRANCHES and PATRONS ASSOCIATION

The Association has nine branches under its direct control (Barry Joint, Cadoc, Cowbridge, Dinas Powys, Illtyd, Llantwit Major, Rhoose, Peterston & Wenvoe and Western Vale).

Friends of the Vale (FoV) is a patrons' association which operates outside the control of the Association. It generates funds purely to support specific election campaign expenditure.

The cash balance as of 31st December 2022 amounted to £22,394. These figures are not included in the Income & Expenditure Account on Page 4 nor the Balance Sheet on Page 5.

The Glamorgan Business Club was established to raise funds for the Association. The available balance on 31st December 2022 was £6,821. These figures are not included in the Income & Expenditure Account on Page 4 nor the Balance Sheet on Page 5.

INCOME

Subscription income and donations during the period amounted to £7,632. (2021 £14,861).

Total income (including subscriptions and donations) attributable to the Unit was £17,752 (2021 £16,748).

EXPENDITURE

Total expenditure for 2022 was £29,476 (2021 £27,626).

FINANCIAL RESULT

The outcome for the year shows a deficit of **-£11,724** against a deficit of **-£10**,878 the previous year.

COMMITTEES

The Association Executive Council, who manage the business of the Association, met regularly during the year and whenever necessary.


