The main political activity of the party was to fight elections in its area. There were District Council elections in May and 3 by-elections in the year in June, August and December. There was also a by-election for the County Council in December.

#### **Branches**

The party had 1 branch in the year. All income and expenditure incurred by the branches has been included in these accounts.

#### Financial overview

Income comes from donations and fundraising activity. There is increased income compared to last year as a result of the many by-elections in the year and preparations for a general election in 2024. Expenditure is incurred on campaigning activity and the employment of staff and has also increased as a result of the increased political activity in the year.

#### Accounting notes

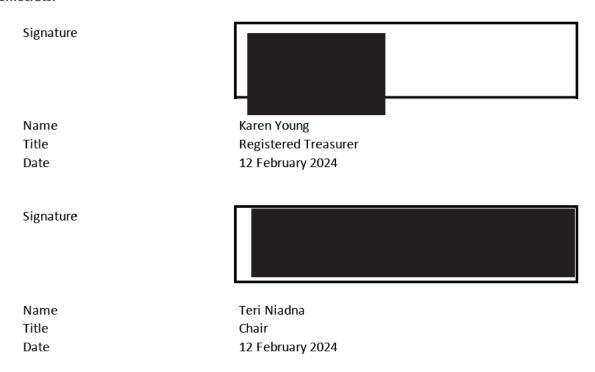
The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with applicable accounting standards and guidance issued by the Electoral Commission. The accruals method of accounting has been used.
