REVIEW OF POLITICAL ACTIVITIES

There were no elections in 2023. Canvassing events increased over the year, together with a monthly stall in Truro.

A fundraising and awareness raising meal was organised which also involved the neighbouring constituency,

Membership reduced notably again in 2023 March 2022 806

Although income from membership is higher than the previous year as a result of membership income for Nov 22 £1096.62 being credited to the CLP account Jan 23.

REVIEW OF FINANCIAL ACTIVITIES

A brief summary to the CLP's income and expenditure for 2023 including significant changes since last year

Donations increased significantly year on year by £32191, (£1468 in 2022 to £33659 in 2023) due
to large one off contributions, following the selection of the PPC. These have been fully and

transparently reported in line with party policies and Electoral Commission requirements. Large donors were from Member Mark Wilson £10k. Unison £8k. and two donations which were received via Labour Party HO £7500 from a Social Justice Funded Group, and £2500 form a donor making donations to Female candidates.

- Property costs increased by £2094, reflecting the new office at rented wef 14th October 23 . The Premises account reduced by £25,000 from £48517 in 2022 to £23517 in 2023 because of the match funding commitment in respect of employing a full time Organiser. However as yet we have not received a clarifying statement from Labour Head Office.
- Membership income rose by £940 (£1646 in 2022 to £2587 in 2023), as a result of November 22 membership income not being received from HO until January 23.
- One off fund raising event at the Alverton Hotel contributed a one off fund raising of £467 net. Plus the raffle held at the event which raised £133.
- Campaigning costs increased by £688 reflecting increase in campaigning and the printing of leaflets locally. (£1436 in 2022 to £2124 in 2023)
- Conference expenses reduced by a notable amount of £866 (£1141 in 2022 and £275 in 2023) due to only sending one candidate.

As a result, despite the premises account reducing by £25000, the overall net asset position has improved by £7255 (£56022 in 2022 to £63277 in 2023), thanks to the generous donations received.
