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Political activities Overview of political activities

The Association stood 33 candidates for Wyre Forest District Council election in May 2023. 20 candidates were elected resulting in Conservatives obtaining overall control of the District Council. There have been no other election or byelections in the report period. There have been no changes or boundary changes to the Parliamentary Constituency resulting from Electoral Commission Boundary Review.

Branches

There Association has 4 active branches; Wolverley Branch covering the parish ward of Wolverley; Chaddesley Corbett covering the parish ward of Chaddesley Corbett; Eastern Branch covering the district council wards of Broadwaters, Offmore and Comberton, and Aggborough and Spennells; and Western Branch covering the district council wards of Franche and Habberley North, Blakebrook and Habberley South, and Foley Park and Hoo Brook.
