There was an increase in the membership at the beginning of 2022 to take advantage of leadership elections and in the runup to the Local Council elections in May 2022. Membership numbers have since fallen off during 2023. Whilst the Membership fee has increased from £25 to £39 for new members during 2023 (and for all renewing members in 2024), the levy retained by CCHQ has also increased from £10 to £15.60. Subsequently some members who had previously been paying the minimum fee have not renewed.

In 2022, a donation of £16,667 was given from the Wandsworth Council Conservative group towards local election campaigning costs.

Significant effort was put into building up the Patrons Club in 2023. In 2022, the main fundraiser was a highly successful Gala event for the launch of the Local Council election campaign. Fundraising in 2023 was greatly subdued as the Association struggled with the loss of the Council.

There was a realised gain on the Vanguard Life Strategy Fund units as at the 31 December 2023, reversing the loss from 2022.
