Financial Activities

Income overview

Membership was down some 20% over the year with a commensurate drop in income. Rental from the upstairs apartment continued to contribute significantly to the Association's financial position. However, this was offset somewhat by the costs for a new mixer unit and new boiler midway through the year.

Donations increased significantly as a result of Jonathan Hulley's active campaigning.

A significant interruption occurred at the beginning of November when Barclays unexpectedly closed our account, apparently for inadequate information with respect to Money Laundering Regulations. The account was reinstated early December but it caused a major hiccup in the day to day running of income and expenditure.
