Statement of Accounts for the year ending 31st December 2023

Introduction

This statement of accounts provides a report on the political and financial activities of the Association whose registered address is:



For the purposes of the Political Parties Elections Referendums Act 2000 Rosalyn Neale is the Registered Treasurer and Subankani Pratheepan, the Deputy Registered Treasurer.

Overview of political activities

During the year Clir Susan Hall AM was selected as our London Mayoral candidate and Stefan Bucovineanul-Voloseniuc as our Brent and Harrow GLA candidate. These elections will be held in May 2024.

We also selected our Prospective Parliamentary Candidate Abbas Merali.

The year has been spent regularly campaigning for the GLA elections and latterly the General Election to be held at some point in 2024.

Members also helped at the Uxbridge and South Ruislip by election, our efforts contributed to the success and the seat was retained.

Membership

Membership decreased during the year, in part due to losing members following a boundary review change, we started the year with 311 members and finished with 270 members.

Branches

The Association is now comprised of 11 wards, with the addition of Wealdstone North as a new ward following the Parliamentary Boundary Review. Some have amalgamated so that we have 4 branches.

Fundraising

During the year a Quiz night, a Race night and an On Line event where Jacob Rees-Mogg MP spoke to members and took questions were held. All were very well attended raising monies for the Association. A hustings was also held which Susan Hall and another candidate running to be our candidate for Mayor of London attended. Once Susan had been selected we held an event where members could meet her, hear her speak and ask questions.

Review of financial activities.

Overview

The Association has enjoyed a stable financial year with the 3 lettings of office space continuing and there being no major expenses incurred relating to the building. This, together with car park income from the increased rental charges introduced in the previous financial year, has enabled us to see an increased net income before taxation.

This is despite employing an Office Administrator, after a volunteer undertook the role for the previous 2 years and membership receipts reducing.

We therefore see ourselves in a healthy position to run the 2 election campaigns detailed above.
