Overview of political activities

Throughout the year, political activity was focused on rebuilding electoral support for the party, following 2022 poor performance in the election of councillors for the newly created unitary council of North Yorkshire.

Preparation commenced for mayoral elections and a general election both anticipated in 2024.

Financial Activities

Income overview

Income in 2023 was materially impacted by the 2022 decision to sell property and reduce our exposure to higher mortgage interest costs associated with our apartments.

Patrons club membership performed well but total membership income was impacted by boundary changes, resulting in the movement of members from Boroughbridge into Wetherby and Easingwold.

Donations also had a material positive impact on income.

Expenditure overview

Continuing expenditure

Cost control was effective, benefitting from the elimination of our mortgage in 2022 and reducing ongoing flat maintenance. We secured the permanent employment of an office and campaigns manager, which is reflected in our outgoings.

Total expenditure was impacted by two significant events. We incurred material costs in transferring funds to Wetherby and Easingwold, reflecting membership changes from the national boundary review and also incurred a tax liability on the flats sold in 2022.

Balance sheet overview

Net assets remained in line with prior year. We retain the ownership of a central Harrogate apartment and have invested property surpluses in centrally managed portfolios of stocks and bonds.
