ORDER

UPON the Petitioner's substituted petition for a winding-up order against the Respondent ("the Company") presented on 22 October 2024

AND UPON hearing Mr Myers of Counsel for the Petitioner and Mr Moffat of Counsel for the Respondent

AND UPON the Company contending that the underlying tax liability was discharged by the delivery to HMRC of a series of alleged 'Money Orders' and the Court listing a final hearing to determine this question

AND UPON the Court dismissing the Company's argument, including on the bases that (a) HMRC was entitled to and did so prescribe approved methods of payment, which do not include 'Money Orders' and (b) in any event, the Court not being satisfied that the alleged 'Money Orders' provided by Mr Rose on the Company's behalf were valid bills of exchange

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Company be wound up by this court under the provisions of the Insolvency Act 1986.

2. The costs of the Petitioner be paid out of the assets of the Company.
